In this diocese, the first celebration will be on Sunday, December 13 at 3:00 pm at St. Joseph Co-Cathedral in Burlington. This will mark the opening of the Holy Door in our diocese. All are welcome to attend the prayer service on this special occasion. Each month there will be a celebration on the third Sunday of the month at 3:00 pm. Various groups will be invited to these services. For example, on January 17, all lay ministers are invited: ushers, lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, musicians and altar servers.
