Parish Finances: You may have noticed that the Sunday collections have been substantially short of our goals the past few weekends. At St. Patrick where our weekly goal is \$1,230, the collections for the past three weekends totaled \$979, \$786, and \$811. In those three weeks we missed the goal by a total of \$1,114. At St. Anthony-St. George, where our weekly goal is \$370, the collections for those same weekends were \$265, \$264, and \$191. We missed the goal by \$390 during that same period. If this trend were to continue, we would find ourselves in serious financial trouble. It is hoped that those who were away or missed for whatever reason might be able to make up their contributions. It's important to remember that even when collections do not meet our goal, the parish expenses still continue.

Franciscan Way of the Cross: On Sunday, March 6th at 6:00 pm, we will be praying the *Franciscan Way of the Cross: The Peace Prayer*, which is framed not only by the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ but by the Franciscan Peace Prayer. This will be held during the time our children attend religious education classes, and geared to their understanding. The reflection at each Station will bring together Jesus' ultimate sacrifice with the Franciscan reminder for peace and harmony in our daily lives, and especially during the Lenten season. All are invited and encouraged to join us for this special celebration of the Stations.
