The Diocese of Burlington uses the safe environment training programs *Safe and Sacred* by Proud to Protect, Inc. to train all clergy, religious, employees, and lay volunteers who are involved in any capacity throughout the Diocese and *Circle of Grace* to educate all children and youth in parish religious education programs and Catholic schools.

Did You Know? April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month and four Evening Prayer of the Night services will be held throughout the Diocese to remember the victims of child abuse and their families. All four services will be held on Tuesday, April 26 at 7:00 pm. All are welcome to attend. The location for northwestern Vermont is in Burlington at St. Joseph Co-Cathedral Parish.
