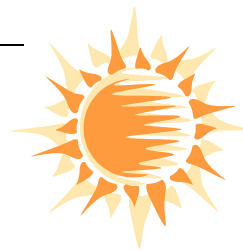

2016 Bishop's Fund: Thank you to all of our parishioners for your support of the **Bishop's Fund Annual Appeal**. For those who have not yet given, you should have received a mailing from the Bishop's Fund office recently providing you with another opportunity to donate.

To date, at St. Patrick's, we have pledged 78% toward our goal of \$12,785. At St. Anthony-St. George, we have pledged 58% toward our goal of \$3,800.
