Year-End Financial Report

St. Patrick:

Income:	\$ 107,177.05
Expenses:	\$ 111,489.09
Net Loss:	\$ -4,312.04

St. Anthony - St. George:

Income:	\$ 39,743.43
Expenses:	\$ 41,104.92
Net Loss:	\$ -1,361.49

Although both parishes show that we had deficits, it is important to note the following: At St. Patrick we had projected a balanced budget which did not include the more than \$10,000 we spent on painting the church. Even after that large expenditure the deficit was only \$4,312. At St. Anthony-St. George, we had projected a deficit of \$4,000 and ended the year with a smaller one of \$1,361. Part of this was due to the gift received from the estate of Freda Burnor.

If you would like a complete financial report you may call the parish office and we will provide one for you. We will be working on the budget for 2016–2017 soon. Thank you.

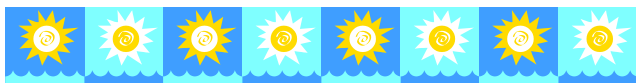


Bishop's Fund:
