Jubilee Year of Mercy: The Jubilee Year of Mercy Celebration for catechists and school teachers will be held at St. Joseph Co-Cathedral at 3:00 pm on September 18th. As the school year begins, this will be an opportunity to celebrate the Year of Mercy with Catholic educators from around the diocese. Confessions will be available to gain the Jubilee indulgence before and after the celebration and light refreshments will be served. Please join us!



Projects Completed: In the past year, a number of projects at both St. Patrick and St. Anthony-St. George Churches have been completed. Your support of the parishes, and especially the second collection on the third Sunday of each month for “Projects”, has helped to make it possible to complete this work. Among the projects completed at St. Patrick’s were: a new door installation at the side (parish hall) entrance of the church, repair work on the front steps, painting window sills and trim inside the church, masonry cleaning and repair at the church and the rectory, exterior scraping, re-glazing and painting of windows and trim on the church, slate roof maintenance and repair on both buildings and exterior painting of the rectory. At St. Anthony-St. George, projects completed were: repair and refinishing of the front door, installation of a new furnace, repairs to the roof, and interior painting of the church. The cost for these eleven projects totaled more than \$37,000. There are no other large projects planned in the near future.

Bishop’s Fund:

Thank you for all of your support of the 2016 Bishop’s Fund Annual Appeal. To date, at St. Patrick’s, we have pledged 108% toward our goal of \$12,785. At St. Anthony-St. George, we have pledged 97% toward our goal of \$3,800. Fuel Collection:

One of our two annual collections for “Fuel” will be taken up on September 3 – 4. Last year, the total for heating the two churches and the rectory came to just under \$16,000.00. The total for the two collections was just over \$6,500. Once again, we encourage you to make as large a donation as your means allow in order to off-set this significant expense. If you are not able to contribute next weekend, your donation will be welcomed at any later date.

Presbyteral Assembly: The annual gathering of all the priests of our diocese with the bishop will take place from September 6-8 at the Lake Morey Inn and Resort in Fairlee. The Presbyteral Assembly gives us the opportunity each year to be together for prayer, study and fraternity. In response to input from the recently reconstituted Diocesan Pastoral Council, Bishop Coyne has invited us to focus our reflections on “The Preaching Office of the Priest.” Since the bishop’s background includes teaching Homiletics (preaching) at the seminary, he will lead us in this effort. Please keep the bishop and all of our priests in your prayers.

Attention Catechists: There will be a regional Catechetical In-Service for all catechists on Saturday, September 10, 2016 from 9:00 am until 12:45 pm at St. John Vianney Church in South Burlington. There are two breakout sessions offering a variety of topics of interest to teachers and aides. Please return registration forms to the church office no later than September 2.
