**Louisiana Support:** In response to a request from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, Bishop Coyne has directed that an emergency collection be taken to support the humanitarian efforts of Catholic Charities, USA in providing pastoral and rebuilding support to Catholic dioceses impacted by the recent storms in Louisiana. As many as 60,000 homes were damaged, with nearly 20,000 people being rescued from the flood waters.
