Jubilee Year of Mercy: You are all invited to attend a very special Jubilee Celebration for the Year of Mercy. There will be a healing service on October 16 at 3:00PM at the St. Joseph Co-Cathedral. It will consist of Eucharistic Adoration, witness talks and three types of healing stations. One station will be for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for Catholics; another will be for the biblical laying on of hands in the more Charismatic tradition; and, the third will be Confessions available throughout the celebration for those able to receive it. This event is open to the public, and especially those suffering physically, mentally, spiritually, with addictions and/or other problems requiring God's mercy and healing.
