## **2017 Bishop's Annual Appeal:**

You will have likely received at least one request by this date from Bishop Coyne asking for your support for the Bishop's Annual Appeal. Please respond generously. In addition to



monies distributed for charitable works, including Vermont Catholic Charities, the diocese is able to be a valuable resource to all parishes, large and small. This week, you'll meet staff from our Safe Environments department, as well as human resources. They could not continue all that they do, statewide, without your support. Please visit [Bishopsappealvt.org](http://Bishopsappealvt.org) to see how these two departments offer services and support beyond the Chancery, to all parishes. Remember, our parish receives direct assistance, so each and every one of us should feel inspired to give. To date, we are at 75% at St. Patrick's and 49% at St. Anthony-St. George of our annual goal. If you have not yet given to this year's appeal, pledge forms may be found at the church entrances.

## **DeGoesbriand Grants:**

Vermont Catholic Charities recently awarded 27 grants to nonprofit organizations in Vermont serving the most vulnerable through the Bishop DeGoesbriand Appeal for Human Advancement totaling \$58,139. Each November Vermont parishes take a second collection to support this grant program. One hundred percent of the money collected is distributed in the form of grants to local non-profit organizations who seek to create a higher quality of life in their communities at, for example, homeless shelters, right to life programs, and food programs for children and families. Since the program began in 2011, Vermont Catholic Charities has awarded grants totaling more than \$377,000. Local organizations receiving grants this year were: Aspire Together (\$1,000) Burlington and St. Albans, and Martha's Kitchen (\$4,000) St. Albans.
