Income: \$ 113,108.81
Expenses: \$ 98,154.16
Net Gain: \$ 14,954.65

St. Anthony-St. George:

Income: \$ 43,033.93
Expenses: \$ 34,296.72
Net Gain: \$ 8,737.21

We had projected a \$2,000.00 surplus for St. Patrick, and a balanced budget for St. Anthony-St. George, so as you can see, we did better than we had expected.
