Expense: \$ 29,548.28

St. Anthony-St. George

Income: \$ 9,367.43

Expense: \$ 12,486.95

Note: For both parishes, this figure includes the annual insurance premium, a large expense which will eventually even out throughout the rest of the fiscal year.
