Once the budgets have been finalized we'll be able to post new weekly goals for our Sunday Offering in the bulletin. (For your information, this past year's weekly averages were \$1,294 and \$389. The previous year's averages were \$1,303 and \$397.)

2018 Bishop's Annual Appeal

"How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" (Ps 133:1) You likely have received at least one request from Bishop Coyne requesting your support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal. We are getting closer to our goal and ask that you prayerfully consider the request and respond generously. St. Patrick Parish is now at 65% of our pledge goal (\$8,555 toward goal of \$13,179), and St. Anthony-St. George is at 99% of pledge goal (\$3,589 toward goal of \$3,618). Thank you to all who have participated so far. Pledge cards may be found at the church entrances for those who wish to use them.

Annual Diocesan Family Mass: The Mass will be held at St. Anne's Shrine in Isle LaMotte on Sunday, July 8th at 12:15 pm. Following the Mass, to be celebrated by Bishop Coyne, visitors may picnic on the shrine grounds or on the shore of Lake Champlain. Cost for barbeque is \$10.95 for adults, \$6.95 for children 12 and under; and for families of four or more (two adults and two or more children) \$35.00. 
